





- Support arts integration and project-based learning

- Plan for shared use of key spaces to promote efficient and effective space use





- Promote school spirit, arts integration, and the cultural diversity and pride of the entire student body








- Cafeteria (originally built for elementary school level) inadequate for Middle School needs

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
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
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

- Electrical improvement for Chromebook carts at classrooms


- Science labs lack adequate infrastructure (e.g. no gas)




- Inadequate space at multi-purpose room for lunch service







